



Question 1: Chip says that some online messages are like "sneaky traps." What is it called when someone tries to fool you with a fake link or message?

Correct Answer: (B) Phishing

Why? Chip explained that phishing is when someone tries to trick you into clicking a fake link by pretending to be something cool.





#### Question 2:

You see a shiny button that says "You won a prize!", but you aren't sure if it's real. What is the very first thing you should do?

- A) Click it quickly to get the prize!
- B) Type in your password to see what happens.
- C) Stop and ask a trusted adult.





### **Correct Answer:**

C) Stop and ask a trusted adult.

Why? Chip says if something feels weird or looks too cool, you should always ask an adult before you click.





#### **Question 3:**

Chip says 'smart squirrels know not every acorn is real.'
Which of these is a big clue that a website might be FAKE?

- A) It asks for your secret password or home address.
- B) It has bright colors and pictures.
- C) It takes a long time to load.





## Correct Answer:

A) It asks for your secret password or home address.

# Why?

A stranger or a fake site will often ask for private things like passwords. Real sites won't ask you to share secrets where you shouldn't!
