Question 3:

Why is this important?

- A) Because typing is really hard work.
- B) Because you only get one post a day.
- C) Because once something is online, it can be hard to erase.





Correct Answer: C

Why? Just like a footprint in mud, once you put something on the internet, it is difficult to take it back completely.
